

PASTOR JENNIFER WEGTER-McNELLY

Pastor Jennifer grew up in Minnesota in a church family. She went to Carleton College in Northfield, MN. She received her Bachelor of Arts in Religious Studies and then continued her education at Macalester College in St. Paul, MN where she majored in Art History. She also holds her Master of Divinity from Princeton Theological Seminary in Princeton, NJ. Pastor Jennifer was ordained as a Presbyterian Pastor in 1996. The Presbyterian Church USA is one of the churches with which the ELCA has an ecumenical partnership and ecumenical agreements with which makes it possible for pastors from the Presbyterian Church to serve in ELCA congregations.

Pastor Jennifer has over ten years of experience serving as an Interim Pastor and has served churches large and small, from Boston to San Francisco. Most of her ministry has been with congregations in times of transition, conflict and sometimes transformation. Member who have reflected on her ministry with them describe her as 'strong yet gentle'. She has skills in leadership development, and a gift for seeing below the surface of problems and concerns. She listens, but also challenges.

Pastor herself says she 'feels called to a congregation whose members love God and one another, strive to appreciate their differences and seek to be transformed by our spiritual journey together'. They should also desire a pastor who will do ministry with them, rather than for them.

Although Pastor Jennifer has never led a Lutheran service, she has already started to learn the Lutheran liturgy and looks forward to working with the Worship Committees. She loves the rhythm of worship and liturgy, and also sees the creativity of ministry as always being different.

Beginning in September, Pastor Jennifer will serve ten hours per week during the academic year as Chaplain at the Russell Sage Colleges. She is also involved in the School Backpack Program sponsored by the Regional Food Bank in Albany.

Pastor Jennifer lives in Niskayuna with her husband Kirk and their 11 year old son Keller. Pastor's husband is a visiting professor of religious studies at Union College in Schenectady.

COUNCIL SUMMARY

A combined Council meeting with both Faith and Evangelical Councils was held on May 9th to determine whether to ask Pastor Jennifer Wegter-McNelly to join the two congregations as intentional interim pastor. The interview committee discussed Pastor Jennifer's responses during the interview and overall impressions of whether she would be a good fit. A motion was made to ask Pastor Jennifer to serve as interim pastor for Faith and Evangelical. The vote was unanimous 'in favor'. If Pastor Jennifer accepts, her initial period of service will be June 1, 2016 – June 1, 2017.

Fred and Michelle Howard have agreed to serve as representatives to the NYS Upstate Synod Assembly in June.
