It was expected that all three grandchildren would be assembled to welcome her. No excuses - not fish biting, ball games nor bike rides; dare keep us from our proper expression of thankful appreciation for her presence. Strong willed and Germanic, she was very attentive to our progress in school. Her manicured finger could locate a single "B" amid a string of "A's" on the report card. "Billy - if you can make a B, you can make an A." Reading the whole NY Herald Tribune daily kept her very quick mind sharp. Sadly, I had the feeling that, like her knees, her sense of humor was hobbled by arthritis.

She was a woman of deep, unwavering faith - a staunch fan of the Mets from 1962! During "the War" (II) I lived with them on the farm Grandpa Will owned in PA. She played football with me and showed me how to gather eggs each morning. When wet grass and a steep hill kept me from climbing home from the brook, she helped me laugh at myself. "Billv. there's no point in being stupid - - - unless you act it once in a while!" was one of her stated truths! A second like unto it was: "Don't get mad - - you only have to get glad again!" Mary Poppins may have popularized the notion: "Just a spoonful of sugar makes the medicine go down!", but it was Grandma Pauli who was the role model personalizing that mantra.

The neat blessing in all this – an understanding I came to only after I they were gone – is connected with Pentecost, the birthday of the Church - the institution we have dubbed "Holy Mother Church". I was blessed with two strong women in my life that even before I ever thought about Sunday School or cared about the Catechism, they made "Law" and "Gospel" flesh and blood realities. They were preparing me to "get it" when it comes to Mercy and Truth. At least these two ladies gave me a head start on the deep stuff of Holy Mother Church. Hello Everyone,

I would like to update everyone regarding the process and progress that both Faith and Evangelical of Poestenkill are currently at in terms of a call for an Intentional Interim Pastor. (IIP) The Upper NYS Synod did recommend someone to us, and a positive back ground check has occurred. Both Councils have met and have chosen representatives for the interview committee. Members of the interview committee from Faith are: Barbara Boord, Fred Howard, Sara Martin, Diana Rieker and Donna Van Zandt. The committee has met on two occasions to develop a variety of questions for the recommended candidate.

It is anticipated that a formal interview will take place in the near future with a representative of the Upper NYS Synod joining us. Following the interview, if both churches approve, the candidate's name will be presented to Synod for approval.

As this process continues to develop, members of Faith will be kept informed.
