



LENT 2019

Lent is finally coming! March 6th will soon be upon us. Lent are those days of being invited by God. "Come back to me, with all of your heart," our Lord beckons. "We will," we respond, but we aren't quite ready yet, our hearts are not prepared. We want to squirm, evade, avoid. Our souls not yet perfect. We are not ready for God to love us.

Ok, ok, I really will. Just a few things at work; and a little time in prayer. Let me clean my oven, tidy my closets. Sell my yoke of oxen. Check a field I have purchased....

Come back to me, with all of your heart.

It is an extraordinary invitation to each of us. God invites us to drop our defenses and realize that *our* standards of judging and loving are so very different from God's.

From the first day of Lent, the Ash Wednesday readings let God's be clear: "Return to me with your whole heart."

"A clean heart; create for me, O God," Psalm 51 offers. "Give me back the joy of your salvation." That is exactly what our loving God wants to give us, the joy of salvation.

Lent begins in winter when days are cold and dark, perfect for hiding ourselves indoors, perfect for hiding from God. But our God is the parent of the Prodigal Child, waiting faithfully, eagerly looking for our return, night after night. There are no folded arms and stern judging stares, only the straining

Yet we spend so much time trying to think of *how* to return and what to say, how to begin the conversation. It's only when we finally appear, that we understand we don't have to say anything. We only have to show up.

So, what is it that stops us from this great reunion? What keeps us from accepting this invitation to something deeper? Aren't there things we should say first: "If God really knew about me..." It doesn't matter. None of it matters.

Come back to me, with all of your heart.

Accepting this call is simple once we get beyond the fear. All we need say is, "I'm here. Where do I start?" No explanations are necessary.

What's the next step? Take the first moments of our day, before we're out of bed to thank God for opening our hearts to it. We could remember throughout the day the invitation that has moved our hearts: *Come back to me, with all of your heart.* And we can rejoice along with God.

That is the invitation of each day of Lent. Today is the day to accept it.

OUR FAITH at WORK

The featured mission for the month of March will be in support of the work of Literacy Volunteers of Rensselaer County.

Through our donations, Literacy Volunteers provide tutoring in Reading/Basic Literacy and in English as a Second Language to approximately 250 teens and

adults. One-to-One and Small Group Tutoring help individuals learn to read, to write, and to speak English, and to improve their math skills. Tutoring is free and confidential. Students and tutors work together for an average of 2 hours per week to meet students' goals.

Your continued support of the "Pull Tab" and "Box Top" missions is most appreciated. Both missions are receiving donations from the congregation each week. You will find the collection containers on the table in the Narthex.
