## SPECIAL GUEST PREACHER AND PRESENTER ON MARCH 5th

On Sunday, March 5<sup>th</sup>, Faith will welcome Pastor Gregory Tennermann to share through preaching and a time of teaching and discussion after the worship service. Please make plans to stay after that day to participate if you can.

The Council has invited Pastor Greg to share from his extensive experience with congregations like ours in important times of transition. He had a long settled ministry in a vital congregation in New Windsor, New York. Later, he went on to serve as an interim pastor, Synod staff person, and consultant. His special areas of expertise and interest include dynamics within congregations (known as Family Systems theory), healing after conflict or difficulty, and transition times in churches. He and his family have lived in this area for a number of years of his ministry, including

serving as Interim Pastor for some churches in Rensselaer County. Though he officially retired in 2016, he continues to be busy serving as part-time director of natural systems for the Upstate Synod, which includes teaching, coaching, and consulting in the synod.

We hope that many in our congregation will take advantage of the opportunity to hear and ask questions of Pastor Tennermann. His experience, skills, encouragement, and sense of humor are a great resource for Faith as we find our way through our own time of transition.
